What is Safeguarding?

Keeping people safe from harm and abuse

For example - intimidation, threats, bullying, neglect, sexual abuse, domestic abuse, forced marriage, gang violence, modern slavery, radicalisation

What is Radicalisation?

People developing extreme views that encourage terrorist or other illegal activities

What is 'Prevent'?

Stopping people from becoming radicalised before they break the law
